Never Post Inappropriate Content

Never Post Personal Information

Check your pictures before posting them to make sure you don't give away personal information like your phone number or home address. Don't help hackers steal your identity!

Always Report Cyberbullying

If you are a victim of cyberbullying, **report the behavior to a trusted adult right away**. Do not respond to the bully. Take a screen-shot of the conversation and save it to show as evidence.

Always Know Your Friend List

Friend or foe? **Only accept friend requests from people you have met personally**. Just because you have a mutual friend does not mean that account can be trusted. They could be anyone!
